1. The prayer in the present petition for directing the respondent-Commission to decide the representations dated 23.10.2023, 10.11.2023 and 08.07.2024.
2. Learned counsel would contend that the petitioner though belongs to BC-B category, however, being higher in merit, found a place in the General category as her marks being 68, while the cut-off 67. Consequently, she was appointed as a Clerk on 08.09.2020, which she joined on the said date itself, whereon she has been working for the last 4 years. The issue is only with regard to her document verification, which were found in fact to be correct by the Haryana Staff Selection Commission at the time of recommendation and thereafter, by the Department. There being another round of verification for which a revised schedule was issued on 17.05.2022, the roll number of the petitioner figured therein to appear on 06.06.2022, the last date meant for the said purpose. Due to a medical emergency, she was got admitted in the Government Hospital, Sector-6, Panchkula on 04.06.2022, the medical record with regard to which is appended as



Annexure P-6, whereupon even her medical leave was also sanctioned on 23.06.2022, Annexure P-22. But a show cause notice was issued to her for terminating of services, which she challenged in CWP-13711-2022, Annexure P-13, wherein an interim order protecting her services was passed on 12.07.2022 in terms of the one issued in CWP-14017-2022.

3. A similarly situated candidate whose writ petition was a part of bunch of cases decided on 07.10.2023, Annexure P-16 was granted one more opportunity for the documents verification as observed in para 65 and 67 thereof due to medical problem with her daughter. The writ petition of the petitioner was also disposed of on 12.10.2023, Annexure P-18 with liberty to approach the respondent-authorities for grant of another opportunity for the purpose of scrutiny. In terms thereof, a representation has been submitted to the Haryana Staff Selection Commission, duly diarised vide No.8736 dated 23.10.2023, Annexure P-19 as also a communication sent by the Chief Secretary to Government of Haryana dated 10.11.2023, Annexure P-20 addressed to the said authorities, besides another representation dated 08.07.2024, Annexure P-21 to the Chief Principal Secretary, Haryana which has been forwarded on 11.07.2024 to the Haryana Staff Selection Commission. These have however, not yet evoked any response. He thus, at this stage, on instructions from the petitioner, prays that a direction be given to the respondents to decide the same in a time bound manner by granting her an opportunity of hearing.

4. Notice of motion.

5. At the asking of the Court, Mr. Harish Nain, AAG Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and on instruction submits that the same shall be decided within a period of 4 weeks after hearing the petitioner.



- 6. The aforesaid satisfied the learned counsel for the petitioner.
- 7. Disposed of accordingly.
