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GURBIR SINGH, J.

1. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the appellant submits that the present appeal has become infructuous as the appellant has settled the loan account and has repaid the entire amount under the OTS scheme. In the affidavit, it has also been stated that the Bank has also issued ‘No Dues Certificate’ dated 30.11.2023 in favour of the appellant.
