In the meanwhile, petitioner shall join investigation, as and
when required by the Investigating Agency and subject to his reporting to
the Investigating Officer within two week from today, no coercive steps
qua arrest of the petitioner shall be taken. In case, his arrest is required to
be caused, petitioner shall be released on bail by the Arresting Officer till
the next date of hearing on his furnishing personal bonds to the
satisfaction of Arresting Officer. Petitioner shall also abide by all the
conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

To be heard alongwith CRM-M-44679-2023. ”

[2] Today, learned State Counsel, on instructions from SI Vishal Saini, has informed this Court that the petitioner has joined the investigation, in compliance of the order dated 05.10.2023 and is no longer required for further investigation.

[3] In view of the aforesaid, the order dated 05.10.2023, whereby the petitioner was granted interim anticipatory bail, is hereby made absolute. However, he shall continue to join investigation, if and so required by the Investigating Officer.
