1. The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing FIR No.58 dated 22.08.2023 under Sections 452, 380, 427, 323, 506, 148, 149 of the IPC registered at Police Station Mohkampura, District Amritsar, along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 25.08.2023 (Annexure P-2).

2. Case called twice, however, even on the second call there is no representation on behalf of the parties.

3. A perusal of the affidavit dated 18.12.2023 filed on behalf of the respondent/State reveals that there are a number of criminal cases pending against the petitioners namely Mandeep Singh @ Nikka, Gurminder Singh @ Rabbu and Gaurav @ Tund. A further perusal of

the report received from the learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Amritsar reveals that there has been non-compliance of the order dated 18.10.2023 vide which the parties had been directed to get their statements recorded with respect to the compromise so affected between them. As per the report received, none of the parties including the complainant appeared to get their statements recoded.

4. In the aforementioned facts and circumstances, the petition stands dismissed for non prosecution.
