1. Counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner got married with respondent No.5 but the marriage was never consummated and petitioner has already filed divorce petition in the Court concerned at Malerkotla. It is further submitted that respondent No.5 and other members of his family i.e. respondents No.6 to 12 are unnecessarily harassing the petitioner and the petitioner is apprehending threats to her life from the side of the private respondents and in this regard representation Annexure P-2 dated 09.09.2024 was given by the petitioner to respondent No.2 but the police authorities failed to take any action.

2. Notice of motion.

3. Mr. J.S. Dhaliwal, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the State and submits that in case any such representation filed by the petitioner is pending, the same will be decided by the competent authority in accordance with law at the earliest.



4. In view of above, without going into the merits of the case, this petition is hereby disposed of with direction to respondent No.2 to consider and decide representation dated 09.09.2024 (Annexure P-2) and to take action if so warranted in accordance with law.

5. However, any observations made in this order will not be construed as an expression of opinion on the validity of the marriage of the petitioner. In case the petitioner has committed any offence, law will take its own course.
