Prayer in the present petition is for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to provide police help to the respondent No.5 as per the request letter laid down by respondent No.3 to respondent No.2 so that order dated 11.06.2019 (Annexure P-1) be executed as per law.

Short reply by way of affidavit of Swapandeep Kaur, Assistant Collector 1st Grade-cum-Tehsildar, Kapurthala, on behalf of respondents No.3, 4 & 5 has been filed. The same is taken on record. It is stated in the reply that the possession has already been got delivered on 15.07.2024. The relevant extract thereof reads as under:-

“3. That to initiate the proceedings of 'Dakhal' the deponent i.e.



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Assistant Collector 1st Grade-cum-Tehsildar, Kapurthala wrote a letter No. 584/Reader Dated 18.06.2024 to the Circle Kanungo Sidhwan Dona, Distt. Kapurthala.

4. That in compliance with the above said letter No. 584/Reader Dated 18.06.2024 issued by the deponent, the Circle Kanungo Sidhwan Dona, Tehsil & District Kapurthala reported to the deponent that the proceedings of Dakhal have been completed as directed by the office of the deponent. (Copy of Dakhal proceeding which is received from the Circle Kanungo Sidhwan Dona, is attached herewith as Annexure R-1 and translated copy of the same is attached as Annexure R-1/T)."

A perusal of the same shows that requisite possession has already been got delivered. The present petition has been rendered infructuous and is disposed of accordingly.

However, the petitioner is granted liberty to revive the petition, if anything contained in the reply is found to be factually incorrect.
