NAMIT KUMAR, J. (ORAL)

1. Present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of writ in the nature of *mandamus* directing the respondents not to transfer the petitioners from the present place of working, who are working as daily-wagers with the Punjab State Forest Development Corporation, District Patiala to Punjab State Forest Development Corporation, District Sangrur or any other place, without issuing transfer orders; to stay the transfer of the petitioners during the pendency of the petition; not to terminate the services of the petitioners from their present respective post and to pay the salary for the months of July, 2024 and August, 2024 and not to stop the salary of the petitioners.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners had submitted representation dated 23.08.2024 (Annexure P-18), however, no action has been taken thereon till date. He submits

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that at this stage, petitioners would be satisfied, if the said representations are considered and decided by passing a speaking order in a time-bound frame.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Rajesh Sehgal, Addl. A.G., Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents and has no objection to the innocuous prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioners.

5. I have heard learned counsel for the parties and have gone through the record of the case.

6. Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioners in the present petition, respondents No.2 and 3 are directed to consider and decide the claim made by the petitioners in representations dated 23.08.2024 (Annexure P-18) in accordance with law, by passing a speaking order within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

7. The petition stands disposed of.
