The petition has been filed, *inter alia*, seeking a writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to grant the benefit of 3rd ACP with effect from 01.06.2022, with all consequential benefits, as the similarly situated employee has already been granted the benefit.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that at this stage, the petitioner will be satisfied in case he is permitted to make a fresh representation before the respondents raising the grievance as has been raised in this petition, and the same may be ordered to be decided within a specified period

3. Notice of motion.

4. Ms. Tanushree Gupta, Deputy Advocate General, Haryana,



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accepts notice and submits that in case any such representation is filed by the petitioner, the same will be decided by the second respondent expeditiously.

5. In view thereof, without going into the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to file a representation before the concerned respondent within a period of two weeks from today. In case any such representation is filed by the petitioner, the same shall be decided by the second respondent-Director, Department of Elementary Education, as the case may be, by passing a speaking order thereupon, within a period of three months of receiving the representation.

6. In case the order is not passed within the stipulated period, the officer concerned shall pay costs of ₹50,000 to the petitioner.
