Prayer in the present petition is for directing the official respondents to take appropriate action against respondent No.5-Dr. Jai Kishore in terms of the representation dated 01.08.2024 levelling allegations of corruption, extortion, harassment and criminal intimidation.

Status report by way of affidavit of Dr. Manish Bansal, Director General, Health Services, Panchkula (Haryana) along with Annexures on behalf of respondents No.1 and 2 has been filed today in the Court and the same is taken on record. Copy thereof has been furnished to the learned counsel for the petitioner. In the status report, it has been averred in paragraph No.5 that the said representation dated 01.08.2024 and the subsequent complaint dated 16.08.2024 have already been sent to the Chief Vigilance Officer vide memo No.90/J(164)2F5-2024/5144 dated 12.09.2024



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(Annexure R-3) to inquire into the charges made by the petitioner.

The Chief Vigilance Officer (appointed by the Chief Secretary, Haryana for vigilance matters in the office of Director General Health Services, Haryana) vide his office memo dated 22.10.2024 has already summoned the petitioner to get his statement recorded. It is thus apparent that appropriate steps on the complaint(s) submitted by the petitioner have been taken and the matter has been referred to the Chief Vigilance Officer to inquire into the same.

In view of the said status report, the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous.

Ordered accordingly.

Let the inquiry by the Chief Vigilance Officer be concluded expeditiously and preferably within a period of 04 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
