Respondent No. 3-Akshaan Malhotra, Assistant Registrar, Co-operative Societies, Kharar (SAS Nagar), who is present in Court, submits that the petitioner is elected as President of the Society, where he worked as Peon and the remaining benefits amounting to Rs, 1,47,427/- are to be released under his own signatures.

[2] In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition any further.

[3] **Dismissed as not pressed.**

[4] However, in case the aforesaid stand of respondent is found incorrect, the petitioner would be at liberty to seek revival of the present contempt petition and in that eventuality, the erring / concerned officer(s) would be liable to pay additional sum of Rs.50,000/- as costs from his / her own pocket in favour of the petitioner towards litigation

expenses, immediately, i.e. on the first date of listing of revival application.

[5] Rule stands discharged.

[6] Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed off.
