Reply by way of affidavit of Purshotam Kumar, Deputy Secretary to Government of Punjab, Department of Home Affairs on behalf of respondent Nos.1 and 2 has been filed. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to the counsel for the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that they intend to approach the respondents by filing an appropriate representation so as to consider the claim of the petitioners for regularisation on sympathetic grounds even if they are working through outsourcing agency.

Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that the petitioners will also bring to the notice of the authorities concerned the settled principle of law settled by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India and the respondents be directed to pass appropriate speaking order in a time bound manner.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case any representation is received at hands of the petitioners, the same will be decided by the competent authority within a period of eight weeks from the date of the receipt of certified copy of this order by passing an appropriate speaking order. Learned counsel further submits that in case, it is found feasible to accept the claim of the petitioners, the same will be accepted, otherwise due reasons will be mentioned for not accepting the claim of the petitioners in the speaking order to be passed and the said order will be duly conveyed to the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the statement of learned counsel for the respondents, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty to file an appropriate representation.
