With reference to our orders dated September 25, 2024 as also September 27, 2024, additional affidavit of Director (Admin.), Punjab State Institute of Sports, Punjab Yuwa Bhawan, Sector 42, Chandigarh, dated 30.09.2024, filed in Court today, is taken on record. Copy furnished. And, with reference to an order dated September 27, 2024 (Annexure R3/1), appended therewith, learned State counsel submits that the blacklisting of the petitioner that was for an indefinite period, has since been confined to a period of one year, i.e. from July 29, 2023 to July 28, 2024.

That being so, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that let the petition be disposed of, to enable the petitioner to invoke Clause 5 (Dispute Redressal Mechanism) of the Tender Documents, for redressal of its grievances set out in detail in the petition, and also to question the modified order of blacklisting even for a period of one year. And/or to avail such other remedies as shall be admissible in law.

Accordingly, the petition is disposed of with the liberty prayed for.
