HARKESH MANUJA, J. (ORAL)

Learned counsel for the respondents, on instructions, submits
that the proposal for creation of diminishing cadre post(s) for
accommodating the petitioners towards benefit of regularization stands
approved by the Office of Chief Secretary, Govt. of Haryana on 28.11.2024;
followed by its sanction from the Finance Department, and the necessary
benefits regarding issuance of letter of appointment(s) for regular post(s),
besides consequential / financial benefits shall be issued / released in their
favour within a period of two weeks from today.

[2] In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioners does
not press the present petition any further.

[3] Dismissed as not pressed.

[4] However, in case the needful is not done within the afore-stated period, as per undertaking, the petitioners would be at liberty to seek revival of the present contempt petition and in that eventuality, the erring / concerned officer(s) would be liable to pay additional sum of Rs.50,000/- as costs from his/her own pocket in favour of each of the petitioners towards litigation expenses, immediately, i.e. on the first date of listing of revival application.

[5] Rule stands discharged.

[6] Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed off.
