JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioners through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India are seeking setting aside of orders dated 05.09.2024 (Annexures P-1 to P-3) whereby petitioners have been transferred from Gurdaspur to Malerkotla.

2. The petitioners are posted at district Gurdaspur as Head Constable/ASI. They have been transferred by impugned orders from Gurdaspur to Malerkotla. They are claiming that they have been transferred on account of political connection of their family members. Their family members are part of opposite political party. They have no objection to transfer, however, they are praying that they should be transferred to nearby districts where multiple posts are lying vacant.

3. Mr. Aman Dhir, DAG, Punjab on instructions from ASI Ganesh Kumar submits that if this Court directs, the Competent

Authority would consider representation of petitioners and if possible they would be adjusted at nearby places.

4. In the wake of submissions of both sides, this Court finds it appropriate to direct the respondents to consider representation dated 12.09.2024 (Annexures P-4 to P-6) of the petitioners and if possible adjust at nearby places.

5. Disposed of.
