1. The present Criminal Writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of direction to official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of private respondents.

While referring to the status report, learned State counsel informs that the statements of petitioners were recorded, which have been appended as Annexures R-1 and R-2 along with their affidavits (Annexures R-3 and R-4), wherein, it has been expressed by the petitioners that there is no threat perception to their life and liberty at the hands of respondents No.4 and 5, thereby rendering the present petition as infructuous.
