1. The counsel for the petitioner submits that son of the petitioner is settled in New Zealand and he helped respondent No.4 to go to New Zealand and never took any money from the said respondent. After reaching New Zealand, respondent No.4 committed sexual assault on a lady and in order to escape punishment respondent No.4 came back to India and thereafter, lodged false complaint against the petitioner and his son to extract money from them. It is further submitted that the police is unnecessarily calling the petitioner to the police station in connection with aforesaid false complaint. Being aggrieved, the petitioner gave representation Annexure P-7 dated 12.09.2024 to respondent No.2 but the police authorities failed to take any action. The counsel further submits that petitioner will be satisfied if necessary direction is given to respondent No.2 to decide representation Annexure P-7.

2. Notice of motion.



3. Mr. J.S. Dhaliwal, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents NO.1 to 3-State and submits that in case any such representation filed by the petitioner is pending, the same will be considered and decided by the competent authority in accordance with law.
4. In view of above and without going into the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2 to consider and decide representation (Annexure P-7) in accordance with law within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
5. Police authorities are also directed that the processing of any complaint lodged by respondent No.4 against the present petitioner is to be done only in accordance with law and not otherwise.
