On oral request made by learned counsel for the petitioner
Section 201 IPC is ordered to be added in the head note as well as prayer
clause of the petition. Learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to carry
out the necessary correction in this regard in the Court today itself.

The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 438 Cr.
PC with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to him in case FIR No.142, dated
06.09.2023, under Sections 379-B, 323,506,148,149 of IPC and 201,342 and
500 of IPC (added later on), registered at Police Station Nathana, District
Bathinda.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of
the order dated 11.10.2023 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the

investigation.

Learned State counsel also submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for further investigation.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of complainant has vehemently opposed the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

In view of the above statement made by learned State counsel, the interim order dated 11.10.2023 is made absolute. The petitioner shall continue to join the investigation, as and when called by the Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438 Cr. PC.
