1. This second petition has been filed under Section 483 B.N.S.S.
seeking grant of post-arrest bail in:-

28	05.02.2020	City Rupnagar, District Rupnagar	376, 354, 354-A, 506, 384, 120-B IPC and Sections 6, 8, 12, 14, 15 and 16 of POCSO Act, 2012 and Section 77 of Juvenile Justice Act.
