KULDEEP TIWARI, J.(Oral)

1. Petitioner no.1, who is already married, and having three children, without taking divorce from her earlier wedlock, decided to walk out from her matrimonial relationship, and started living in '*Live-in-relationship*', with petitioner no.2, and having apprehension to their lives and liberty, filed criminal writ petition under Articles 226 of the Constitution of India, for issuance of directions to the official respondents no.2 and 3 to protect their lives and liberty at the hands of private respondent no.4.

2. Learned State counsel, who is on an advance notice, on instructions imparted to him HC Gursewak Singh, informs this Court that an inquiry was conducted in the instant matter, and during inquiry statement of respondent no.4, has been recorded, wherein he has categorically stated that he has no objection to the relationship of present

petitioners. Therefore, as on today, there is no threat perceptions to the present petitioners.

3. In view of the above statement of learned State counsel, no direction is required to be passed in the instant matter. Therefore, the instant petition is hereby ordered to be **closed**.
