The petitioners have approached this Court for seeking issuance of directions to official respondents No.5 and 6 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents No.7 to 11.

A further prayer was made for issuance of directions to the respondents No.1 to 4 to issue Medical Card i.e. Mother-Child Protection Card for pregnancy check-up and immunization of the petitioner No.1 who is four months pregnant.

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It was specifically stated on behalf of the State that the medical card i.e. Mother Child Protection Card for pregnancy check-up and immunization already stands issued in favour of petitioner No.1.

Status report by way of affidavit of Gurkirpal Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, PBI, Homicide and Forensic, Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran, on behalf of respondents No.5 and 6 has been filed in the Court today.

It has been averred in the aforesaid status report that the police has conducted verification of the facts pertaining to the matter and also recorded the statements of the private respondents. They specifically submitted that the petitioners have performed the marriage with each other with their own consent and after leaving the house, the petitioners never came back at the house and they pleaded ignorance about their whereabouts and further stated that they did not have any objection to their marriage and have not extended any threats nor they will ever threaten the petitioners at any point of time in future. It is further stated that the local police is duty bound to protect the life and liberty of every individual and that appropriate steps would be taken in accordance with law in case any fresh material is received with respect to extension of any threat.

In view of aforesaid stand of the respondents that there is no subsisting threat and that they have taken appropriate steps to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

Ordered accordingly.

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Liberty is, however, granted to the petitioners to furnish any such evidence/material to the competent authority as would establish the existence of any threat.

Needless to mention that in the event of any such material being furnished, appropriate steps in accordance with law shall be undertaken by the respondent authorities.
