HARKESH MANUJA, J.(ORAL)

1. In furtherence of the last order dated 22.10.2024, learned counsel for the respondents has relied upon a speaking order dated 29.10.2024 whereby services of the petitioner have been reinstated with continuity of services with 50% back wages. Mr. Vipin Kumar Singh, Divisional Forest Officer, Jhajjar, who has appeared through video conferencing informs that the payment regarding financial benefits shall be released to the petitioner within 15 days from today.
2. In view of the aforesaid undertaking, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition at this stage and submits that the same be disposed of with liberty to revive the same in case needful is not done.
3. Ordered accordingly.
4. However, in case the needful is not done within the aforementioned period, as per the undertaking, the petitioner would be at liberty to seek revival of the contempt petition and in that eventuality, the

respondent would be liable to pay additional sum of Rs.50,000/- as costs from his own pocket in favour of the petitioner towards litigation expenses, immediately, i.e. on the first date of listing of revival application.

5. Rule stands discharged.
