1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. with a prayer to direct the respondents No. 2 and 3 to conduct fair and impartial investigation in a case FIR No. 0047 dated 18.04.2023 under Sections 306 and 34 IPC registered at Police Station Garhshankar.
2. On advance notice, Mr. I.P.S. Sahbarwal, DAG, Punjab, has appeared on behalf of the official respondents. Learned State counsel submits that in the present case, all the accused have been granted the concession of anticipatory bail by the Court. He further submits that in the present case, the viscera report has already been received by the police. However, the suicide note was sent to the handwriting expert for comparison of the handwriting of the deceased but no report from the handwriting expert has been received, so far. Learned State counsel further submits that on receipt of the report from the handwriting expert, every endeavor shall be made to conclude the investigation at the earliest. He has further assured the Court that the investigation shall be conducted fairly and impartially.
3. In view of the statement made by the learned State counsel, no further directions are required and the petition is disposed off, accordingly.
