2. CRWP-9652-2023 (O&M)

The present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the  
Constitution of India read with Section 482 of Cr.P.C. seeking issuance of  
direction to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the  
petitioner as well as her family members at the hands of private respondents.

3. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner has  
submitted that the petitioner has filed a representation dated 22.08.2023 to  
Superintendent of Police, Yamuna Nagar (Annexure P-2) raising her

grievances as raised in the present petition but the same has not yet been considered and no action has been taken thereon. He further submitted that the petitioner and her family are apprehending threat at the hands of private respondents and at this stage, the petitioner would feel satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to respondent No. 3-Superintendent of Police, Yamuna Nagar to decide the aforesaid representation filed by the petitioner and take necessary action thereon.

4. Notice of motion.
5. Mr. Arjun Lakhanpal, Addl. A.G., Punjab, who is present in Court, has accepted the notice on behalf of the respondent-State and submits that the needful will be done in due course. Let a complete set of the paperbook be supplied to him during the course of the day.
6. In view of the limited prayer made by the petitioner, without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of at this stage with a direction to respondent No. 3 to decide the aforesaid representation of the petitioner within a period of two months from today, by passing a speaking order in accordance with law. Needless to say, if any threat is found to the petitioner or her family members, the official respondents would provide them adequate security in order to protect their life and liberty.
