1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 528 of B.N.S.S with a prayer to issue appropriate directions to the official respondents to conduct the fair and impartial investigation in case arising out of FIR No. 77 dated 16.04.2019 under Sections 452,324,506,427,148,149 of IPC and Sections 25 and 27 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Ajnala, Police District Amritsar (Rural). A further prayer has been made to direct the official respondents to look into the representation dated 31.07.2024 (Annexure P-2)
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already submitted a representation dated 31.07.2024 (Annexure P-2) to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Police District Amritsar Rural, District Amritsar,-respondent No.3 and he shall be satisfied at this stage, if directions are issued to respondent No.3 to look into the matter and take appropriate steps,

in accordance with law.

3. In view of the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner and without expressing anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed with a direction to respondent No.3- Senior Superintendent of Police, Police District Amritsar Rural, District Amritsar, to look into the matter and take appropriate action within two months, in accordance with law.
