1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as the petitioner was facing disciplinary proceedings in the year 2022, she was transferred out of Fazilka to Muktsar but ultimately the petitioner was found innocent in the said disciplinary proceedings and the post in Fazilka, where the petitioner was working is still lying vacant, hence, the respondents be directed to transfer the petitioner to said post at Fazilka so that no inconvenience and prejudice is caused to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the grievance raised in the present petition has already been raised in the representation, a copy of which has been appended as Annexure P-9 and the petitioner will be satisfied at this stage in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the same by passing appropriate speaking order.
3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Mr.TPS Chawla, Sr.DAG, Punjab, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case any representation has been received, the same will be decided by the authorities concerned within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order by passing a speaking order and in case, it is found feasible to accept the same, the same will be done otherwise due reasons will be mentioned in the speaking order for not accepting the claim of the petitioner for her information and necessary action.
6. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned counsel for the respondents, the present writ petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
