1. This is a Civil Revision Petition filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India for expediting the proceedings in HMA-1509-2023 titled as “Nitash Gupta vs.Anshita Vig” pending in the Court of Additional Principal Judge, Family Court, Gurugram, Haryana.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in the present case, the Hon'ble Supreme Court vide order dated 04.08.2023 had while transferring the case from the Court of Principal Judge, Family Court, Rae Bareli, Uttar Pradesh to Principal Judge, Family Court, Gurugram, Haryana, further granted opportunity to the present petitioner to appear before the Court through video conferencing facility and it was also observed that in case such request is made, the Court shall make available video conferencing facility to the petitioner. The relevant portion of the



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above said order, which has been highlighted, is reproduced hereinbelow:-

“However, liberty is reserved to the respondent to appear before the Court in the aforesaid matter through video conferencing facility. If such a request is made, the Court shall make available video conferencing facility to the respondent herein.

Pending application (s), if any, shall stand disposed of.”

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner be permitted to withdraw the present petition with liberty to move an application in pursuance of the above said order passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court before the Additional Principal Judge, Family Court, Gurugram, for appearing on 27.01.2025 through video conferencing facility.
4. In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the aforesaid liberty.
