SHEEL NAGU, CHIEF JUSTICE (Oral)

1. The petitioner, who is an aspirant for admission to M. Phil Clinical Psychology course – 2024, has filed this petition.

2. Learned counsel for the respondents informs that Entrance Examination for admission to the aforesaid course was held on 07.09.2024 and the tentative/provisional answer key was uploaded on website of the Department on 08.09.2024. Thereafter, several candidates raised objections to the same and sought correction in the answer key. The objections were considered by the Expert Committee on 11.09.2024 and the final result was declared on 12.09.2024. The petitioner, thereafter, made a representation on 13.09.2024 raising five objections.



3. Learned counsel for the respondents, however, on telephonic instructions received from Dr. Dasari Harish, Chairperson Exam Cell, Govt. Medical College & Hospital, Sector 32, Chandigarh, submits that out of five objections raised by the petitioner, four have already been considered by the Expert Committee, based on the objections made by other candidates. Fifth objection could not be considered, since final result was already declared by the time, the petitioner raised objections.
4. Learned counsel for the petitioner, at this juncture, submits that in view of the information given by learned counsel for the respondents, the grievance raised by the petitioner does not survive.
5. Accordingly, the petition stands disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to re-visit the Court, in case any grievance remains un-redressed.
