In the present petition, the challenge is to the order dated 28.10.2022 (Annexure P-13) transferring the petitioner from Shri Hargobind Government Senior Secondary School, Mandi Gobind Garh, District Fatehgarh Sahib to Government Senior Secondary School Sanur, District Patiala on the ground of mala fides.

2. While issuing notice of motion, the operation of the said transfer order was stayed and the petitioner was allowed to continue at Shri Hargobind Government Senior Secondary School, Mandi Gobind Garh, District Fatehgarh Sahib.



3. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that the minimum stay at a particular station has already been completed by the petitioner and even otherwise, the petitioner is due for transfer.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the order of transfer impugned in the present petition be not given affect but in case, the transfer of petitioner is due henceforth as per transfer policy, he will have no objection to that.

5. Learned counsel for the respondents on instructions from Sh. Prit Pal Singh, Junior Assistant, O/o DEO (Elementary), Fatehgarh Sahib submits that the impugned order of transfer dated 28.10.2022 will not be given affect to especially, when the same has already been stayed by this Court and in case, the department intends to transfer the petitioner henceforth as per transfer policy, the said order will be passed in accordance with law.

6. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in view of the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

7. Ordered accordingly.

8. Pending miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
