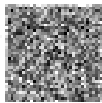

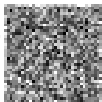

ANIL KSHETARPAL, J(Oral)

1. With the consent of the learned counsel representing the parties, two connected cases, i.e. one second appeal against order and one civil revision petition shall stand disposed of by this common order.
2. The petitioner/appellant prays for permission to file the appeal without the payment of Court fees on the ground that she does not have means to pay Court fee.
3. It has come on record that the petitioner/appellant is wife of a former IAS Officer and she purchased plot No.262 at Narotam Nagar, Khanna, in April, 1999 and Booth No.69 at Guru Amardas Market, Khanna, in the year 1994-1995. She also purchased a Maruti car in the year 1998.



4. On a Court question, the learned counsel representing the petitioner/appellant is unable to disclose the size of the plot and the accommodation constructed in the aforesaid plot. It has also come on record that the appellant is getting monthly maintenance at the rate of Rs.8,500/- per month.

5. Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the First Appellate Court is directed to call fresh report from the Collector disclosing all these facts. After the receipt of report, the Court will take a fresh decision on the application for permission to file the appeal without payment of Court fees.

6. With these observations, the second appeal against order as well as civil revision petition are disposed of.

7. The parties through their learned counsel are directed to appear before the First Appellate Court on 05.07.2024.

8. All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
