KULDEEP TIWARI, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioner, who is a minor, through his uncle, has approached this Court by filing the instant petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, whereby, prayer is made for protection of his life and liberty.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the father and mother of the petitioner are accused in FIR No. 0137 dated 29.4.2024, registered at Police Station Sector 13/17, Panipat under Sections 406, 409 and 420 IPC, wherein his mother has already been granted the relief of anticipatory bail, whereas, the petition filed by his father seeking anticipatory bail is pending consideration and despite that the police is again and again harassing him, by calling him to the Police Station and asking for the



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whereabouts of his parents. He further submits that the petitioner being a minor child, cannot be harassed for the act and deeds of his parents.

3. This Court vide order dated 23.9.2024 had issued notice of motion to the State.

4. Today, the learned State counsel on instructions imparted to him by J.S.Bangu, DSP informs this Court that the investigating agency has no intention to call the present petitioner for investigation in the instant FIR and they also assure this Court that in future as well the petitioner shall not be subjected to any enquiry or investigation in the instant FIR, to which he is not the accused.

5. In view of the above, the instant petition is **disposed** of.
