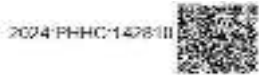
1 This second petition has been filed under Section 483 of BNSS read with Section 528 BNSS for grant of interim bail for a period of 3 weeks in F.I.R. No.74 dated 23.03.2023 registered under Sections 21/21-C/27/29 of NDPS Act, Sections 411 & 473 IPC, at Police Station Special Task Force, District STF Wing, SAS Nagar (Mohali).

2 As per the case of the prosecution, the petitioner was found to be in conscious possession of 2.230 kg of heroin. The interim bail having sought on the ground that marriage of only sister of the petitioner namely, Shilpa Saini is scheduled for 15.11.2024.

3 Notice of motion.

4 Mr. Solomon Partap Singh, AAG, Punjab appears and accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

5 Petitioner is in custody since 23.03.2023. On 24.09.2024, this Court had directed State to file report after verifying the fact regarding



marriage of the sister of petitioner as claimed.

6 Status report by way of affidavit of Ajay Kumar, PPS, DSP, Special Task Force, Ludhiana Range, Ludhiana on behalf of respondent has been filed. The same is taken on record. The factum of there being marriage stands verified and confirmed.

7 Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case, since the marriage functions are to commence on 15.11.2024 and continue till 18.11.2024, the petitioner is ordered to be released on interim bail forthwith to the satisfaction of the jail authorities on 14.11.2024 on furnishing of adequate security. The petitioner shall surrender back with the jail authorities on 20.11.2024. During the aforesaid period the petitioner shall bound by the following conditions :-

- (i) *The petitioner shall not mis-use the liberty granted.*
- (ii) *The petitioner shall not tamper with any evidence oral or documentary during the trial.*
- (iii) *The petitioner shall not absent himself on any date before the trial.*
- (iv) *The petitioner shall not commit any offence while on bail.*
- (v) *The petitioner shall deposit his passport, if any with the jail authorities.*
- (vi) *The petitioner shall give his cellphone number to the jail authorities and shall not change his cell-phone number without permission of the trial Court.*
- (vii) *The petitioner shall not in any manner try to delay the trial.*

8 In view of above, present petition stands disposed off.
