

**101 IN THE HIGH COURT OF PUNJAB AND HARYANA AT
CHANDIGARH**

Learned counsel for the petitioner relies upon the judgment dated 27.04.2022 passed in CRM-M-17318-2022 (Sikander Singh Gill Vs. State of Punjab) to contend that the petitioner be granted protection from his arrest upto 15.02.2024, as the petitioner is willing to come to India and submit to the jurisdiction of law. He further submits that the settlement has already been arrived at between the petitioner and respondent No.2.

Mr. Adhiraj Singh, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of
respondent No.1-State.

Mr. Amar Pal, Advocate, has put appearance on behalf of respondent No.2.

Learned counsel for respondent No.2 ratifies the stand taken by the learned counsel for the petitioner regarding settlement between the parties.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties and perusing the paper book, the present petition is disposed of by granting protection to the petitioner from his arrest till 15.02.2024 to enable him to come back to India and accede to the jurisdiction of law.

It is made clear that the instant order is being passed in the peculiar facts and circumstances of the case and shall not be treated as precedent.

Disposed of accordingly.
