The present petition has been preferred under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 *inter alia* directing the respondent No.1 to 3 to conduct fair and impartial investigation in respect to Representation/complaint dated 10.09.2024 (Annexure P-5), moved by the petitioners and further issue directions to respondent Nos. 1 to 3 to take action in time bound manner as per the parameters laid down by the Supreme Court in *Lalita Kumari v. Government of Uttar Pradesh & Ors. 2013(4) RCR (Criminal) 979*.

2. The petitioners have approached this Court without even waiting for hearing and outcome of the enquiry conducted on the representation dated 10.09.2024. The petition is pre-mature.

3. In view of this, learned counsel for the petitioners prays for withdrawal of the present petition with liberty to avail the remedy in accordance with law.

4. Permitted to do so.

5. The present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.
