1. The aforesaid petition was filed on 15.10.2019 by Mr. Amit Sharma, Advocate. However, certain objections were raised by the Registry.
2. As per Rule 9, Chapter I, Part A, Volume V, Punjab and Haryana High Court Rules and Orders, the petition, on which objections have been raised by the Registry is to be taken back by the counsel/party, who filed it, to re-file within a period of 40 days. However, the same was not taken back for refilling after removal of objections. On failure to do the needful, the case is to be listed before the Court for orders.
