The petitioner has filed this petition under Section 483 BNSS seeking grant of regular bail to him in case FIR No.0109 dated 23.06.2023 under Section 21 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substance Act, 1985 (in short, the NDPS Act) registered at Police Station Gate Beas, District Amritsar.

Learned State counsel has filed custody certificate dated 26.09.2024 which is taken on record and in terms thereof, the petitioner has undergone total sentence of 1 year 2 months and 18 days. He also submits that Section 29 of NDPS Act has also been added vide DD No.15 dated 25.06.2023.

Faced with this and after arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the present petition with liberty to file a fresh petition with better particulars.

Prayer is accepted.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforementioned.
