1. Prayer in this writ petition filed by the petitioner under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, is for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus, directing the respondents to regularize the services of the petitioner in view of Policy dated 04.03.1999 (Annexure P-1), adopted by the respondents vide office order dated 07.05.2014 (Annexure P-2) and in view of order dated 28.10.2014 (Annexure P-4), passed by this Court in CWP no.1933 of 2014, titled as “Kanta Rani vs State of Punjab and others” and judgment dated 29.04.2016 (Annexure P-5) in LPA No.771 of 2015.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner, at the very outset, confines his prayer for deciding legal notice dated 12.07.2024 (Annexure P-6). He submits that at this stage, petitioner would be satisfied, if the said legal notice is decided by passing a speaking order within a time bound frame.

Without going into the merits of the case at this stage, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.1 to decide legal notice dated 12.07.2024 (Annexure P-6), submitted by the petitioner expeditiously, by passing a speaking order, preferably within a period of 03 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
