Counsel for the petitioners submits that the present petition has been filed by run-away couple who performed marriage against the wishes of respondents No.4 to 8, who are extending threats to cause harm to the petitioners and in this regard, representation dated 17.09.2024 (Annexure P-5) is already submitted by the petitioners to respondent No.2 i.e. Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar (Rural).

- 2. Notice of motion.
- 3. Mr. Jasjeet Singh Dhaliwal, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 and on instructions from ASI Kewal Singh submits that both the petitioners made statements before the police to the effect that now they are not apprehending any threat from the side of private respondents. The copies of the concerned statements are taken on record.



4. Counsel for the petitioners submits that he is having clear instructions that even now the private respondents are extending threats to the petitioners.
5. In light of the above, without going into the merits of the case, this petition is hereby disposed of with direction to Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar (Rural) to consider representation dated 17.09.2024 (Annexure P-5) and to take action if so warranted in accordance with law.
6. However, any observations made in this order will not be construed as an expression of opinion on the validity of the marriage of the petitioners. In case the petitioners have committed any offence, law will take its own course.
