1. The present petition has been filed by the petitioner seeking grant of anticipatory bail in criminal case having FIR No.93 dated 21.07.2023 registered under Section 420 of IPC at Police Station Amargarh, District Malerkotla (Annexure P-1).
2. On the last date of hearing, the petitioner was granted interim bail with directions to join the investigation with the police.
3. Today, counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the aforesaid order, the petitioner has joined the investigation with the police.
4. Reply by way of affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Amargarh, District Malerkotla has been filed on behalf of the respondent-

6. In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order of interim bail dated 03.10.2023 passed by this Court is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) of Cr.P.C.
