The instant petition has been preferred by the petitioner seeking issuance of an appropriate writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to release balance amount of Rs.22,50,646/- including security qua certain development works executed by the petitioner along with interest @ 12% per annum.

2 The petitioner claims to be Government Contractor having been allotted the certain development works as detailed in para No.2 of the present petition vide the allotment letter dated 23.09.2020.

3 Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the various development works as tabulated in para No.2 of the petition stand

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successfully executed, however, the payment against the execution of the said works has not been released yet, even though the final bills submitted by the petitioner already stands approved by the competent authority. He contends that in this regard, a legal notice dated 20.08.2024 (Annexure P-3) has been sent by the petitioner and that despite lapse of a period of about one month since the date of the legal notice neither any decision has been taken thereupon nor has the due and undisputed payment been released by the respondents. He further contends that he would be satisfied in case the respondent-Authorities are directed to look into the legal notice and the grievance espoused by the petitioner therein and a speaking order is passed thereupon in accordance with law and in a time bound manner.

4 Notice of motion.

5 On the asking of the Court, Ms. Akshita Chauhan, DAG, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents No.1 and 2 and Mr. Rajnikant Upadhyay, Advocate, for Mr. Vikram Preet Arora, Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.3 and 4 and submit that they have no objection to the aforesaid prayer being granted.

6 Accordingly, with the consent of the parties and without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of and respondent No.4 - the Executive Officer, Nagar Panchayat, Dirba, District Sangrur, is directed to take note of the legal notice dated 20.08.2024 (Annexure P-3) sent by the petitioner and to pass a reasoned and speaking order thereupon in accordance with law preferably within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

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7 Needless to mention that in the event the entitlement of the petitioner being established as per law, the payment due to the petitioner shall be released expeditiously and preferably within a further period of three months.

8 In the event of non-payment of dues within the said period, the same shall be released along with interest @ 6% per annum from the date of filing of the present petition to be paid to the petitioner and further subject to additional payment of a cost of Rs.50,000/- to be deposited with the PGI Poor Patients’ Welfare Fund, Chandigarh. The said additional financial liability on accrued interest and cost shall be subject to recovery from the erring officials.

9 Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
