KULDEEP TIWARI. J.(Oral)

1. Through the instant petition, under Section 482 Cr.P.C., prayer is made for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 3, to transfer the investigation, to some independent agency like CBI, in the FIR No.213, dated 02.08.2018, registered under Sections 307/302/201 of IPC, at Police Station IT Park Chandigarh, so that fair and impartial inquiry in aforesaid FIR can be conducted.
2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the prosecution agency has concluded the investigation, and thereupon filed the final report, and even most of the prosecution witnesses have been examined.
3. In view of the above supervening events, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the present petition has become infructuous,
4. The instant petition is **dismissed** as having been rendered infructuous.
