By way of present petition filed under Section 482 of BNSS, 2023, petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR (Annexure P-1) as under:

FIR No.	Dated	Sections	Police Station
54	08.05.2024	406, 420 of IPC	Bhupani, Faridabad, Haryana.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance to the order dated 23.09.2024 passed by this Court, the petitioner has already joined the investigation and as such prayed for confirming the interim bail granted vide order dated 23.09.2024.

3. Learned State counsel, on instructions received from ASI Jamshed Ali, intimates the Court that the petitioner has joined investigation and is neither required for further investigation nor for any custodial interrogation.

4. During the course of hearing on 23.09.2024, following order

was passed:



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“Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the dispute is civil in nature and the complainant has not raised the said issues for last 10 years. He further submits that petitioner is ready to execute the sale deed in favour of the complainant but she is not coming forward.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. B.S. Virk, Senior DAG, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and prays for time to get necessary instructions in the matter.

Adjourned to 15.10.2024.

Let the reply be filed on or before the next date of hearing with an advance copy to the counsel opposite.

In the meantime, the petitioner is directed to be released on interim bail subject to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer on his joining investigation as and when called for and cooperate in investigation and also shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 482 (2) BNSS, 2023.”

5. Keeping in view the above submissions made by learned State counsel and the fact that the petitioner had joined the investigation consequent to the order dated 23.09.2024 passed by this Court, interim bail granted vide order dated 23.09.2024 is hereby confirmed, subject to conditions as envisaged under Section 482 (2) of BNSS, 2023. Further the petitioner is directed to join investigation as and when required in future by way of written notice for such purpose to be served by Investigating Officer of this case upon the petitioner; he will not tamper with the



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evidence nor will influence the witnesses and will not leave the country without prior permission of the Court.

6. The petition stands allowed.
7. It is made clear that anything contained hereinabove shall not be construed to be an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
