Prayer in the present petition is for issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents/State to grant regular parole to the petitioner for a period of ten weeks in view of the application submitted by the wife of the petitioner on his behalf before the respondent No.4 (Annexure P-1) dated 29.07.2024 to enable the petitioner to avail the said parole period for performing his familial duties and obligations in view of the fact that the regular parole application of the petitioner had been previously rejected to be entertained and the petitioner not having granted his due statutory right for the year of 2024 and to have the same be decided at the earliest by considering the facts and law regarding the Parole and in view of the judgment of this Hon'ble High Court in case titled "Sanjay vs. State of Haryana and others" bearing CWP No.1980 of 2018 decided on 08.08.2018.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has already filed an application dated 29.07.2024 (Annexure P-1) before respondent No.4, however, no action has been taken on the same till date.

3. Notice of motion to the official respondents only.
4. Mr. Sumit Jain, Addl. AG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.
5. After hearing learned counsel for the parties, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 i.e. District Magistrate to ensure that the application dated 29.07.2024 (Annexure P-1) filed on behalf of the petitioner is decided in accordance with law within a period of four weeks from today.
