1. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the juniors of the petitioners are getting more pay than the petitioners, which is arbitrary and illegal hence, the respondents are liable to step up the pay of the petitioners equivalent to their juniors.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the grievance raised in the present petition has already been raised in the legal notice dated 05.08.2024, a copy of which has been appended as Annexure P-13 and the petitioners will be satisfied at this stage in case, a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the same by passing appropriate speaking order.
3. Notice of motion.
4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Charanpreet Singh, AAG, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.



5. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case, any legal notice dated 05.08.2024 (Annexure P-13) is received from the petitioners, the same will be considered and an appropriate order on the same will be passed within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of any such representation and in case, it is found feasible, the request of the petitioners will be accepted, otherwise due reasons will be given while passing the order on the representation for not accepting the request of the petitioners and the same will be conveyed to the petitioners.

6. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in view of the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
