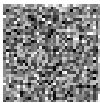

1. The present writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of *mandamus* directing the respondent-Board to grant full pension to the petitioner with effect from 01.02.2008 in light of the judgment passed by a Full Bench of this Court in CWP-17310-2015 and other connected writ petitions on 19.07.2024 (Annexure P-1) and all arrears be released with market rate of interest.
2. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submitted that the petitioner had served a legal notice dated 08.08.2024 (Annexure P-2) to respondent No.1-Chief Administrator, Haryana State Agricultural Marketing Board, Panchkula but the same has not been considered and decided till date. He further submitted that at this stage, the petitioner will be satisfied in case the aforesaid legal notice dated 08.08.2024 (Annexure P-2) is considered and



decided by respondent No.1-Chief Administrator, Haryana State Agricultural Marketing Board, Panchkula in accordance with law and in a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion.
4. On the asking of the Court, Ms. Rajni Gupta, Addl. A.G., Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of all the respondent. She submitted that in view of the limited prayer made by learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner, she has no objection in case a time bound direction is issued in this regard.
5. In view of the aforesaid facts and circumstances, without calling for the reply from the respondent and without expressing anything on the merits of the case, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent/competent authority to consider and decide the legal notice dated 08.08.2024 (Annexure P-2) strictly in accordance with law and within a period of three months from today.
