The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents No.2 and 3 to ensure the protection of life and liberty of the petitioner and his workers as they apprehend imminent threats at the hands of respondents No.5 to 9.
2. Learned State counsel, on instructions from SHO Police Station Bhikhiwind, District Tarn Taran, submits that adequate protection shall be provided to the petitioner and his workers while executing the Government contract for the season of 2024-2025. Learned State counsel further assured the Court that in case, lives and liberty of the petitioner and his workers is threatened by any one, the petitioner shall be at liberty to move an appropriate application to the concerned police officials and necessary and prompt action shall be taken against them.
3. In view of the above, no further directions are required and the present petition is disposed of accordingly.
