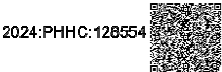

The petition has been filed *inter alia* seeking a direction to the respondents to declare the petitioners' result for the post of TGT, applied by them in response to advertisement 2 of 2023, dated 21.02.2023, and issue appointment letters to them.

2. Pursuant to the last order dated 20.09.2024, petitioners' results have been produced, which have been retained on record as Annexures 'A' and 'B'. The results show the first petitioner-Vandana has secured more than the cut-off marks in Rest of Haryana (ROH) as well as Mewat (MWT) cadre under general/unreserved women category, and has been selected in category no.7 for the post of TGT Science (ROH); the second petitioner-Vijay has secured more than the cut-off marks in ROH cadre under EWS category, and has been selected in category no.7 for the post of TGT Science (ROH); the third petitioner-Anil Kumar has secured more than the cut-off marks in Mewat cadre under EWS category, and has been selected in category no.9

for the post of TGT Hindi (MWT); and the fourth petitioner-Salinder has



secured more than the cut-off marks in ROH cadre under Scheduled Castes category, and has been selected in category no.1 for the post of TGT English (ROH).

3. In view thereof, the Commission is directed to recommend the petitioners, who shall be appointed by the Department as TGTs in their respective categories as per merit, subject to their fulfilling the requisite conditions. The appointment shall be with all notional service benefits from the date other selected candidates pursuant to the advertisement in question have been appointed. The direction shall be carried out by the respondents within four weeks of receiving a certified copy of the order.
