1. The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Article 226 of the Constitution of India read with Section 528 of BNSS, 2023 seeking issuance of directions to official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of private respondents and take appropriate legal action against them in terms of their representation dated 12.09.2024 (*Annexure P-5*).

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the petitioner has filed the aforesaid representation on 12.09.2024 (*Annexure P-5*) before respondent No. 2-Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar raising their grievances as raised in the present petition but the same has not yet been considered and no action has been taken thereon. She further submitted that at this stage, the petitioners would feel satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to respondent No. 2 to decide the aforesaid representation filed by the petitioner and take necessary action thereon.



3. Learned State counsel has submitted that the needful will be done in due course. Let a complete set of the paperbook be supplied to him during the course of the day, if not already supplied.
4. In view of the limited prayer made by the petitioners, without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of at this stage with a direction to respondent No. 2-Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar to decide the aforesaid representation of the petitioners within a period of one month from today, by passing a speaking order in accordance with law and take necessary action, if so required.
