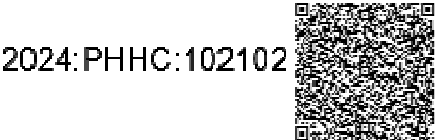

MANISHA BATRA, J. (Oral)

1. The present criminal writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of directions to respondent Nos. 2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners from the hands of the private respondents.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioners has placed on record a copy of order dated 15.01.2024 passed by the Family Court, Jind in a petition filed by petitioner No. 1 and respondent No. 7 showing that the marriage between them has been dissolved by a decree of divorce by way of mutual consent. It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners that they do not want to seek any relief against respondent No. 7 and his name may be deleted from the array of parties.



3. Respondent Nos. 6 and 8, who are present in person along with their counsel, have stated that neither they have extended any threat to the petitioners nor they would do so and the petitioners have no apprehension of danger to their life and liberty at their hands.
4. As per status report filed by the respondent-State, after conducting a detailed inquiry, it has been found that the petitioners, who are in live-in-relationship, have no danger to their life and liberty at the hands of the private respondents. The statements of the private respondents as well as the petitioners have also been recorded to this effect, which are attached with the status report.
5. Learned counsel for the petitioners has not disputed the aforesaid facts and has submitted that the present petition may be disposed of.
6. Ordered accordingly.
