The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to him in case FIR No.417 dated 22.08.2023, registered under Sections 148, 149, 323, 307, 427 & 120-B of IPC and Section 25 of Arms act, 1959, at Police Station Sadar Yamuna Nagar, District Yamuna Nagar.
