HARKESH MANUJA J. (Oral)

1. By way of present petition, prayer has been made for initiation of contempt proceedings against the respondents on account of alleged willful non-compliance of order dated 26.06.2024 passed by this Court in CWP-5701-2022.
2. Learned State counsel, on instructions from Mr. Jatinder Singh, Senior Assistant, DPI (Schools) informs that the appointment letter has been issued in favour of the petitioner and he shall be made to join the duty today itself. He further informs that arrears of salary shall be paid to the petitioner within a period of 01 week from today.
3. In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner does not want to press the present petition.
4. Dismissed as not pressed. Rule stands discharged.

5. However, in case the needful is not done within the
aforementioned period, as per the undertaking, the petitioner would be at
liberty to seek revival of contempt petition and in that eventuality, the
erring/concerned officer would be liable to pay a sum of Rs.50,000/- as costs
from his/her own pocket in favour of the petitioner towards litigation
expenses, immediately, i.e. on the first date of listing of revival application.
